TWO PRESSING ISSUES ON TOMORROW'S CITY COUNCIL AGENDA

Agenda Item 9-1: TREASURER DUTIES & COMPENSATION In 2018, the City Council unanimously passed Resolution 2018-110, codifying the City Treasurer's position as full-time with a salary of \$5424. plus benefits. By October of that year, citing allegations of mismanagement, the same Council stripped the elected Treasurer of half her duties and half her salary. She then stopped showing up for her job, yet continued to collect her salary for the next 3 years without working. During the City Treasurer elections of 2022, winning candidate <u>Tim</u> Goodrich asserted that the Treasurer's position should be reduced to part time, with the same salary as the City Council receives - \$100. a month. In the last year and a half, Mr. Goodrich, while completing the duties of his elected position, has been working at another job full time. The Council could decide to revise the job description and compensation for the office of City Treasurer at tomorrow's meeting.

Agenda Item 10- D: AIRPORT FEES

According to COTAR (the Coalition for Torrance Airport Reform), "Tuesday the 28th will be a critical time for getting the Airport under control. The Council will consider an ordinance to charge landing fees at the airport. While the Council approved a resolution in July to charge fees, it has not yet enacted an ordinance to make them official and determine the rate."
