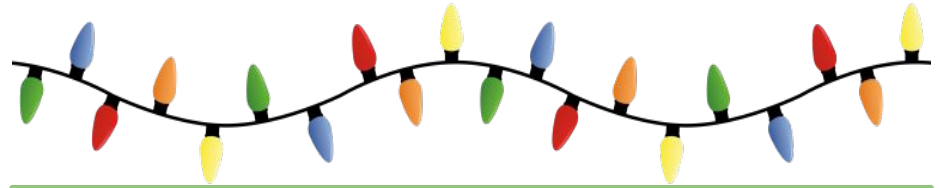
At a special meeting on September 19, the City Council removed a Commissioner just 6 days after he was sworn in.
