HOLIDAY LIGHTS DISPLAYS 2022 INFORMATION

20 additional trash cans marked HOLIDAY will be distributed in the Lights Display area by December 9th. Residents, please LEAVE THEM ON THE STREETS as the Sanitation Dept. has added trash pickups in the area on Mondays and Fridays.

The Emergency Access Lanes (EALs) will be monitored by TPD starting Friday, December 9th. The EALs generally alternate sides of the street each year. Parking there is a ticketable offense.

Out of respect for the tranquility of the neighborhood, residents request that all lights be turned off & noise cease by 10:00 PM every night.

The City Roving Vendors Ordinance continues, meaning it is illegal to sell on the narrow sidewalks in the Lights neighborhood. Call 211 to report the presence of a roving vendor in the neighborhood. Call 911 if there is an emergency.

NOTE FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER'S OFFICE
“The City will not be issuing business licenses to the residents of Seaside to sell items from their residences. As staffing permits, our Environmental Quality Officers will be roaming the area to advise illegal street vendors (including residents) of their inability to vend and to provide educational materials on how to become a legal vendor... EQ Officers do not have the ability to write citations.”
